Enriches the Chapter experience through added special events and social activities including the annual Scholarship Golf Tournament fundraiser, holiday social, and local sporting events.</p>
<p><b>Academic Relations</b> Establishes and expands collaborations with Bay Area universities and professors, interviews and selects scholarship candidates, and awards scholarships. Maintains contact with Scholarship award winners during their career advancement by encouraging and facilitating FEISV's Rising Stars Advisory Board.
